Tote made from upcycled coffee bags.
About 18" x 16" x 6"



Tote made from grain bag
With separate inner sleeve
Made from coffee bags
8" diameter, 15" tall



Tote made from grain bag
With lining made from coffee
size 8" x 10 x 16"



Totes made from feed bags
not lined, about 14" x 14" x 6"



Hamper with lid
made from feed bags
size 26" x 17" x 17"



Tote made from feed bags
Lined with feed bag material
Velcro closure at top
size 14" x 14" x 6"



Recycle Container made from
coffee bags, double layer
Size 14" x 18" x 7"



Tote made from feed bags
Lined with a pocket and
Velcro closure on top
Size 14" x 14" x 6"
